

## **About Your Spelling Words**

Each of this week's words have a pattern of letters like this: vowel-consonant-consonant-vowel.

There is usually a syllable break between the consonants in these words. Notice that the first syllable in each VCCV word ends with a consonant sound. The second syllable always begins with a consonant sound.
