

## About Your Spelling Words

Each of this week's words have the letters $W, X, Y$, and/or $Z$ in it. Be careful when spelling the following words:

- Taxicab - Many people think it is two words, but it is actually a compound word.
- Zoology - This word has three Os in it. Think of spelling the word in three parts: zoo $+\log +y$.
- Rhythm - This is an unusual word because it does not have any of the five main vowels ( $a, e, i, o, u$ ) in it. In this word, the letter $y$ is a vowel that makes the short-i sound.
